Child Prostitution:
The Worst Forms of
Child Labour Convention,
of the International Labor
Organization (ILO)
provides that the use,
procuring or offering of
a child for prostitution is
one of the worst forms of
child labour.

This convention, adopted in 1999, provides that countries that had ratified it must eliminate the practice urgently. It enjoys the fastest pace of ratifications in the ILO's history since 1919. \*The prostitution of children is seen as forming part of the commercial sexual exploitation of children (CSEC), and is sometimes connected to the trafficking of children for sexual purposes, and to child pornography. Child sex tourism also falls within the category of the prostitution of children.
